

While the role of 'Director of 'The Bridge' Youth Centre' with Youth Unlimited is new to me, it holds an air of familiarity. It's familiar to me because my brother held this position a few years ago for seven years, and because I've been involved with Youth Unlimited in a number of different ways for years.

There are a number of different programs at 'The Bridge' including, an arts program called 'Freestyle Arts Studio', an after-school program called 'Master-Piece Theatre' that is geared towards younger youth, Nooma Nights, an evening for discussion and media, a girl's group, and of course 'drop-in' program we initially began with. My new position at 'The Bridge' oversees the smooth operation all of these programs, explores the possibilities for new ones, and seeks to recruit and connect both volunteers who run them, and the youth who attend them. This is what I'm most excited about, Youth Unlimited holds a very 'holistic' approach to sharing the good news of Christ.

Youth Unlimited constantly encourage building relationships; and so, part of my job will be to hang out, get to know, encourage and provide guidance for youth on an individual basis. I recently had the opportunity to share part of my passion for Christ, with a friend "David". This friendship was made through the drop-in program, and developed over years of 'foosball' playing (another one of my passions). I shared with David, my excitement of a short book I'd read that day; a debate on the subject of 'Is Christianity Good for the World,' David was interested so I let him borrow my book. The next time I saw him, he shared with me his excitement about the book and the topics it brought up. He also told me that his mother had picked up and read the book, and was interested in more. Our discussions continue (as does our foosball rivalry), and David and myself are planning on making a short video that intrigues others to look for answers to some these bigger questions in life.

I'm incredible thankful for the support of Kawartha Community Church, and I am excited for all the opportunities may come from being involved with a 'church for people who aren't into church' and a downtown community that isn't into a traditional church.
